Remembrance Activities



Our Remembrance Day activities will take place on Friday November 10.

The reception classes will have a red theme in their classrooms. The red construction materials will be mixed and enhanced with red vehicles and materials. The children will learn about Remembrance Day, understanding the significance of the poppy. A short animation from CBeebies will show the importance of the poppy. The children will also create a class wreath and make their own poppies.

Our Year 1 and Year 2 children will learn about 'who' and 'what' we remember on Remembrance Day and 'why' it is important. They will create a field of poppies at the front of school to show their own remembrance.

In recognition of Remembrance Day the children in Years 3 and 4 will be using the book, 'Where the Poppies Now Grow', by Hilary Robinson as the focus for their English and Reading lessons. They will explore what it was like for children during the World War 2. Poppies will also be the focus for their art work when they will be using illustrations from the book to complete some abstract expressionism pieces.

Year 5 and 6 will be participating in a variety of Remembrance Day activities. They will create a piece of art focusing on a silhouette of a soldier or WW2 plane. Also, we will learn about the life of children during the World Wars. Finally, the classes will take part in a live assembly on Friday morning which ends with a minutes silence to remember the people who have died during wars.
