The highlight came at the end, when the entire arena filled with water for a spectacular fountain finale that lit up the theatre. The children were amazed by the performers' incredible skills and couldn't stop talking about their favourite acts on the way home.

### Circus Skills Workshops



Children in Years 3 and 4 had an exciting time during a high-energy workshop with Jolly Jess and the team from Showtime Circus. The sessions were filled with fun as the children explored a range of circus skills including stilt walking, hula hooping, plate spinning and using pedal walkers to practise their uni-cycling skills. They also had a go at flower sticks, learning to control a central stick with two hands - a real test of coordination. A highlight of the day was the aerial hoop, with every child having the chance to try it out and experience the thrill of circus performance.

## DT Day for Year 3 and Year 4

The children practised key food preparation techniques including chopping, slicing, peeling and grating. The end results were delicious and the children were very proud to taste their finished dishes.

## Music Day at Holland Moor



The whole school thoroughly enjoyed celebrating Music Day. Each year group listened to, appraised, and enthusiastically joined in with new music from a variety of countries, deepening their understanding of different cultures and instruments. The children showed great enthusiasm throughout the day, fully immersing themselves in the experience and demonstrating a genuine appreciation for the diversity and richness of global musical traditions.

KS1 enjoyed a fantastic afternoon exploring music from around the world. Year 1 discovered the vibrant sounds of India, getting involved with energetic drumming and lively Bhangra dancing. Meanwhile, Year 2 took a musical journey to Australia, where they explored

traditional Aboriginal music and listened to the unique and captivating sound of the didgeridoo.

Year 3 explored the magical sounds of classic Chinese music, while Year 4 enjoyed the lively rhythms of Ireland. The children listened to the national anthems of the respective countries, evaluated traditional musical styles, and used a variety of percussion instruments to accompany the music. They also had great fun joining in with traditional dances.

As part of Music Day, Year 5 explored the vibrant music and culture of Spain, focusing on flamenco from the Andalusia region. They listened to traditional pieces, discussed how they made them feel, and identified key instruments like guitars and castanets. The children had great fun practising rhythmic clapping (palmas), experimenting with castanets and foot stomps.
