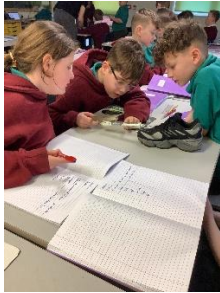
Mr Beale's Highlight of the Week
